100 MINUTES READER PARTICIPATION INCENTIVE:

TEACHER ACTION STEPS

1. PLACE YOUR READER REWARD METER ON YOUR WALL OR VISIBLE TO STUDENTS

Have your reward meter FILLED OUT and ready to be placed on your wall before the program has its official launch, whether that be pep-rally or kick-off video. It is best to put the meter in the background of your camera view so that students can see your progress! Come up with FREE incentives that the students can use teamwork to achieve!

2. UPDATE YOUR READER AND MONEY METER DAILY

- Update your Reader Meter side by 10 (MP5) Minutes Per Student every day. (The students are challenged each day to read 10 extra minutes on the honor system)!
- Update your Money Meter side by logging in to the TEACHER PORTAL on your school website to see real-time updates to your classroom totals and participation rate. Make sure you color your progress! When your students achieve a level, it is best to execute that reward STRAIGHT AWAY so that the students push themselves for the next level immediately.

3. COMMUNICATE VIA EMAIL, SEESAW, OR DOJO TO YOUR PARENTS DAILY

Make sure you communicate with your parents about the things happening in your class. Possible topics are:

- Fundraiser Progress
- Classroom Theme
- Next Reward Meter incentive
- Classroom Team Name
- Encouraging message
- Fun Moments
- School Financial Goals

3. PROMOTE DONATIONS DAILY

- Remind your parents to reach out to sponsors.
- Celebrate students who get donations
- Announce Reward Meter progress and motivate next level
- Try and get a corporate sponsor or business to match your classroom total!

HOW TO REWARD METER

Come up with your own incentives for your classroom. Use this Reward Meter as a guide. Reward the students when it is convenient to you! Ask your admin for permission if you feel an incentive is a bit crazy. Also, all of the incentives should be VIDEO rewards that can be executed in your virtual classroom.
